Introduction

- Kidney transplantation is a life-extending procedure
- Treatment of choice for patients with End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD)
- In Arunachal Pradesh
 - 97 patients (male 68, female 29) undergone renal transplant surgery in various hospital outside Arunachal Pradesh from 2008-2018 (as per NOC issued by DHS)
 - 50% of NOC issued for CMC Vellore
 - 309 dialysis sessions (male 227, female 82) taken place at Tomo Riba Institute of Health and Medical Sciences (TRIHMS), Naharlagun from 2017 to till January 2018

Introduction

- On March 12, 2018, Government of Arunachal Pradesh announced to provide financial aid to patients with ESRD with ceiling amount of 10 lakhs per patient
- Society to be formed as Chief Minister Renal Replacement Society (bye-laws, memorandum, executive committee and Standard Operating Procedure) **UNDER PROCESS**

Aims and objectives

- To establish a pool of fund called as Chief Minister Renal Replacement Fund
- To provide financial aid to patients undergoing kidney transplant
- To minimise time required to provide financial aid to patient
- To set up a Standard Operating Procedure for releasing aid to patient
- To provide available resources and dissemination of information to people in need
- To act as Consultant to people in field of renal transplant and support patient in need with necessary facilitation, communication and advice

Standard operating procedure (SOP)

Under process and yet to approved, the mechanism of identifying patients, empanel hospitals and charges of transplant procedures

Beneficiary : only APST

Empanelled hospitals: identifying and working on

Financial aid: 10 lakhs per patient (ceiling amount)

Payment: through DBT to empanelled hospital in two installments at rate of 70:30
